

Certified Safety Expert on Diisocyanates



ISOPA/ALIPA offer 3 options to become a certified safety expert on Diisocyanates

The [regulation \(EU\) 2020/1149](#) introduces a restriction making successful completion of a training mandatory prior to using diisocyanates. “Such training shall be conducted by an expert on occupational safety and health with competence acquired by relevant vocational training.”

Option 1

TÜV Rheinland/ISOPA/ALIPA certified Expert on Diisocyanates

ISOPA/ALIPA in cooperation with TÜV Rheinland offers a 3-day course to become a certified Expert on Diisocyanates against a course fee.

(Available as of February/March 2023)

Option 2

Train the Trainer via Master Trainer

ISOPA/ALIPA in cooperation with **Dr Manfred Giersig** provides a Train the Trainer session including the ISOPA/ALIPA certificate against a course fee.

Available on demand.

Option 3

Expert by acceptance via ISOPA/ALIPA Committee without certificate

ISOPA/ALIPA supports the view that a person who has work experience, if possible with diisocyanates, and/or a relevant education in environment, health and safety (EHS) qualifies for conducting such trainings.

The relevant person applies for registration as an expert by providing at least a Bio and CV and the ISOPA/ALIPA qualification committee will approve the registration.

All experts fulfilling one of the 3 standards above will receive access to our entire training material to provide training. This access will be provided against a contractual agreement safeguarding intellectual property rights as well as making sure good standards at the training conducted are maintained.

Process

Step 1 CV which allows us to justify that the person is an experienced safety expert on diisocyanates

Step 2 Master training with Manfred Giersig or

Virtual discussion with one of our PSSF Project team experts (30 min)

Step 3 Provide Expert on Diisocyanates Certificate

Step 4 Sign Cooperation agreement

Step 5 Give access to the training material -> ISOPA will

Step 6 Obligation to give feedback on the trainings done,

Obligation to purchase per trainee a certificate at the price of 15 €
